

Case Story

Problem:

Many schools offer electronic education programs. The students do, among other things, soldering and repair work. Both teachers and students complained about the irritating fumes that were being spread throughout the facility. Nederman was recommended.

Solution:

The ventilation contractor and the teachers settled for the Bench Top FX 32 arm, due to their versatility and ease of use. 16 bench mounted FX 32 arms were installed. They are connected to an existing ventilation system. A separate on/off switch for the arm extraction is placed in the room.

Result:

Since the installation there is no smell of solder fumes in the room. The arms are easy to work with and to move out of the work area when not in use. The installation of these extraction arms are appreciated both by the students and the teachers.
