

Case Story

Problem:

BMH Marine is located in a farming area and has a number of welding stations that connected to several exhaust fans. The welding is performed on mild and high allow steel with medium to high currents with both MIG/MAG and MMA tools. To avoid releasing metals to the surrounding areas BMH realized they required a filtration system.

Solution:

Nederman was able to install a FilterMax 3000 filtration system at BMH Marine. Equipped with basic cartridges the filtration system was connected to three of the work stations. The installation works well at a low pressure drop and ensures that the surrounding farming community is not polluted with fumes from their welding processes.
